# CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP Health and Safety

All Scouts attending day camp must complete:

- Registration form
- Annual Health Form A, B

This information is REQUIRED and must be submitted with the registration form and camp fee. ALL COVID-19 GUIDELINES FROM THE CDC WILL BE FOLLOWED AT THE TIME OF CAMP.

## WHAT TO BRING:

- **If you are staying for the day ONLY:**
  - **Boy Scout Health forms A and B completed.**
  - **Comfortable clothing.** Day camp t-shirt. Dress for the weather.
  - **Rain gear.** If needed.
  - **Reusable water bottle.**
  - **Swim clothes & towel.** If it gets hot we may need to all jump in the pool!
  - **Insect repellent.**
  - **Sunscreen.**
- **If opting for the overnight, you will additionally need:**
  - **Sleep clothes and next day clothing.**
  - **Toiletries.** A scout is clean!!
  - **Sleeping gear.** This includes: a sleeping bag, a pillow, and cardboard or something to put overtop of your cot. The cots are army style and do not have mattresses.
  - **Flashlight.**

## Drop off and Pick Up Procedure

- When scouts show up in the morning, an adult must stay to be accountable for the youth. Every single scout must have someone accountable for him or her. **The Scout to Adult ratio (leader or parent) is 1:1.** All adults should have clearances and YPT as per BSA guidelines. Parent and Pal is an open area environment, so understand that youth need supervision outside of the summer camp staff.
- If a scout is NOT opting for the overnight, a check out time and place will be designated. The scout will then have to check in the next morning.
- In an effort for greater Scout safety, we thank you for your full cooperation in this matter.
